## SEPTEMBER IS PROCUREMENT MONTH FOR ALL GRADE LEVELS

**WHAT:** Procurement month is when Southeast Christian School parents and students work together to collect and create unique items of value that will be auctioned off at the school-wide fundraising event on 11.03.18. See “Details” section below for procurement ideas and suggestions.

**WHEN:** Tuesday, September 4th is the first day to drop off your items for the fundraising auction event, and any day through the month. September 28<sup>th</sup> is the deadline. All auction items can be dropped off at the school office with the attached “Auction Donation Form.”

## **DEADLINES:**

**August 31** - Each Room Parent will choose and submit their class basket theme to Lesa Payne, [lesahashim@hotmail.com](mailto:lesahashim@hotmail.com) to ensure there is no overlap.

**September 6** - Meeting for AGA event volunteers and supporters, in the church atrium, 8:20 AM, after drop-off. Please come and help us plan this worthwhile and exciting event!

**September 10** – Tickets for AGA go on sale. (Limited space, may sell out quickly!)

**October 17** – Class baskets need to be completed.

**October 28** - Last day to purchase wine for the Wine Grab Bag (see below).

**November 3** – “A Glorious Affair” event held at Villa Parker from 6-10 PM.

**DETAILS:** SECS parents and students will be focused on **TWO IMPORTANT TASKS** during procurement month.

- 1. Collecting items of value from family, friends, and local businesses/community members that can be auctioned off at the event.**  
Please prayerfully consider asking your family members, doctors, dentists, neighbors, etc. if they would like to donate an item, service, or experience for the auction. See ideas and suggestions below! This is an essential task for the success of the fundraiser. (Items must be new and be worth at least \$25.)
  
- 2. Creating a class basket that will be auctioned off during the silent auction!**
  - Room parents will come up with a theme for the class basket and submit their idea to Lesa Payne ([lesahashim@hotmail.com](mailto:lesahashim@hotmail.com)) by August 31st. Class basket ideas are first-come, first-served. See suggestions for basket themes below. Class baskets need to be completed by October 17th.
  - Room parents will coordinate with their class parents to collect and assemble items for the class basket. Used items cannot be accepted.
  - All baskets will be judged by our leadership team.
  - The first winning class basket will earn a Pizza Party, extra recess, and will be recognized on stage at chapel!
  - The second winning class basket will earn a Donut Party, extra recess, and will be mentioned during chapel!

**OTHER TIPS:** Please find a list of donation suggestions below, including basket themes and social party ideas.

Many businesses are very willing to donate services and/or products. Most will require a letter for tax purposes. Please use the procurement / sponsorship letter attached.

Electronics: Gaming systems, smart watches, cameras, tablets, and other cool gadgets.

Fun for Foodies: Keurig coffee machine, kitchen cookware, BBQ gear (always popular), and other unique items for the home.

Other Awesome Stuff: LEGOS, Jewelry, gift cards & gift certificates (food, shopping, specialty services, fun locales).

## WINE GRAB BAG:
